<i>When are they reported?</i>

1. An individual patient can be included in the measurements for multiple pharmacies. Patients are attributed to the pharmacy that processes the most claims for each measure.

2. Your Performance Metrics will reflect scores based on patients and their medications within your pharmacy location's dispensing system. The data will not reflect if a patient is receiving medications from a separate pharmacy. EQuIPP will reflect all claims data from all pharmacies for a patient in the EQuIPP Score.

3. For 2019, PDP is used for measuring diabetes, hypertension, and cholesterol. MA-PDP will be used for SUPD.
