

PharmacyUnited Program Rules

PharmacyUnited is a program designed to combat the opioid crisis. PrescribeWellness will recruit 1,000 high performing pharmacies who will consult with their patients, complete encounters utilizing PrescribeCare, and then be reimbursed for their efforts.

Which Pharmacies can participate: PrescribeCare MSO pharmacies.

Which patients are eligible: Participating pharmacies will have patients identified within their Patient Engagement Center (PEC). Patients eligible for reimbursement must be in risk classes 5, 6, or 7. It is recommended that participants also filter patients who have an MME/day greater than or equal to 50.

Training: There is a required training video which can be found on University. This video has all the details regarding patient identification, conducting and completing encounters, reimbursement potential, and resources.

Encounter Validation Requirements for Reimbursement

The **Opioid Management** template must be used for all PharmacyUnited opioid encounters

Documenting the dispensing of naloxone can occur during encounter 1 or 2 for an additional, one-time reimbursement of \$10.	
Total reimbursement potential per patient in risk class 5, 6, or 7 = \$50	

Encounter #1: An encounter must be documented and completed using the Opioid Management template.

Encounter #2: To receive reimbursement for Encounter 2, an Opioid Management encounter must be documented and completed using the **Opioid Management** template and a MTP must have a **Completed** intervention status. The corresponding medication and the physician accepted recommendation must result in a change in patient medication claims data (either opioid dose lowering, discontinuation of a benzodiazepine and/or discontinuation of carisoprodol).

Naloxone dispense: During either Encounter 1 or Encounter 2, the **Opioid Management** template **Assessment** tab must signify naloxone was dispensed. A subsequent fill of naloxone must be present in the patient medication claims data.

Payment: Payment will be distributed each quarter, approximately 45 days after the quarter has ended. This is to allow time to validate that encounters meet reimbursement criteria.
